### What we've been up to this month...

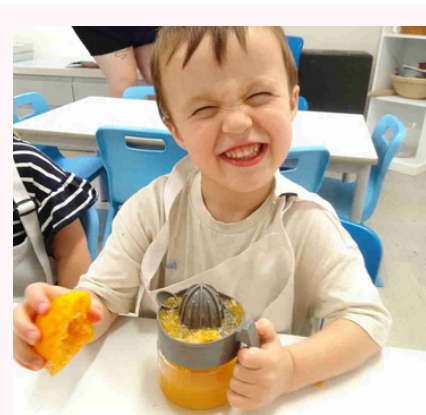
